


Students will be divided up into 6 groups behind a hula hoop at one end of the gym and a mat with the Scrabble Letters spread out on it at the other end. The students will take turns with their group to dribble their basketball down to the other end and pick one letter off the mat and dribble back. When they get back to their group, they should hand the ball to their teammate and write the letter they just brought back on their paper. Groups will only have 4 minutes to get try and get as many letters as they can. After 4 minutes, groups will then use their letters to create as many words as they can using only the letters they have. Once they have created a word and write it down on the lines of their paper, they can reuse the letters to make another word. No abbr. or texting lingo. Proper nouns are ok to use and words must be school appropriate.

3rd & 4th Grade: 3 or more letters in a word 5th & 6th Grade: 4 or more letters in a word
